

TEMPLETON SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
APRIL 18, 2011

The Templeton City Council met on this eighteenth day of April 2011 at 7:00 o'clock p.m. at City Hall, Templeton, Iowa. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Behrens, and the roll was called showing the following named Council Members present and absent:

Approval of Agenda: A motion was made by Engelen and seconded by Stevens to approve the agenda. All in favor, motion carried.

The Templeton City Council and the Templeton Community Betterment Association met to discuss RAGBRAI route through town on Monday, July 25, 2011. A motion was made by Council Member Stevens and seconded by Council Member Bauer for bicyclist to come into town on Railway Street and turn south on Main Street, turn east at the corner of Main Street and 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, turn south at the corner of 2<sup>nd</sup> Street and 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, turn east at the corner of 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, and follow 3<sup>rd</sup> Street out of town. All in favor, motion carried.

Council discussed sample vendor ordinance for RAGBRAI. Recommendation was made that the Templeton Community Betterment Association be the only vendor allowed to provide and sell food to the public during RAGBRAI.

At 8:00 o'clock p.m. and with no further business before the council at that time, they agreed to adjourn. Stevens moved to adjourn and Ramsey seconded the motion. All voted aye, motion carried.
