A motion was made by Spies to approve the agenda, seconded by Sturm. All in favor, motion carried.

A motion was made by Warner to approve the minutes from May 18th, 2015, seconded by Spies. All in favor, motion carried.

- Carol Schoeppner found no discrepancies or misuse of TCBA funds after reviewing the months of April 2015 and May 2015.
- A motion was made by Sturm to accept the Treasurer's report, seconded by McNamara. All in favor, motion carried.

Old Business:

- 2015 NYE Event
 - Board Member Warner will contact friend, Dave, that plays in a band
 - Board Member Schwaller emailed a comedian and juggler from the Carroll County Fair
 - Jazz band was discussed but not acted on
 - Looking at spending \$400-500 for entertainment
- Laptop
 - Board Member McNamara purchased the laptop case
- Taxes

- Board Member Behrens will give to Board Member Warner for taxes next year
- Gun Raffle
 - Board Member Schwaller and husband obtain the prices on guns
 - Guns will come from the three area gun stores
 - \$40/ticket
 - 10% off for the fundraiser
 - 10 guns total
 - \$3,843 (with the discount)
 - \$4,112 (with tax)
 - Need to see 100 tickets to break even
 - Discussed adding the businesses' logos for advertisement on their behalf
 - Discussed purchasing more AR guns because they sell more
 - Winners need not present and announced all at once at the NYE event
 - All players have a chance at all guns
 - Advertise at The Still, different bars around the area, church bulletin, channel 14, have a table at Chicken Supper, and possibly on the radio
 - Discussed 3-4 guns from each location; Wendl's Weapons, Shooters, and Volquartsen's
 - Need a gun raffle license to do raffle, Board Member Schwaller will obtain
- Flags
 - Discussed contacting the Fire Department
 - Discussed starting next year to have all the National Holidays included
 - Discussed asking the youth groups
 - 5x8 flag would cost \$30, and 3x5 flag would cost \$15 from the Dedham Legion
 - Will wait to discuss this again until after January

New Business:

- Halloween Party
 - Board Member McNamara obtained Big Daddy Addy as entertainment
 - \$500 for 6 hours
 - 7pm-1am
 - Discussed having a cover charge of \$5
 - Board Member will contact Big Daddy if he has any interactive games for the audience during the dance
 - Human foosball/drinking games
 - Will make this a costume contest
 - Worst/best/spookiest/scandalous/etc.
 - No charge for renting the facility
 - Have gun raffle table at the event
- 5K Obstacle Course
 - Board Member Strum got prices on courses
 - Very expensive, \$800 for 4 hours
 - Discussing this next year

- Would need to intermingle this idea with another event
 - Street dance
