2. Fireworks update:
- Board Member Walsh reported J & M Sales will borrow him the fireworks tubes at no cost to shoot the July 3, 2013 fireworks.
  - The Templeton Community Fire Department collected enough money from cans and bottles to pay for this year's fireworks display.
3. July 20, 2013 Music Festival update:
- Consensus of board was to order 1,000 ¼ lb. hamburgers from Arcadia Meats.
  - Submit request to the Templeton City Council to close 4<sup>th</sup> Street between 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue on July 20, 2013.
  - Discussed placing barricades north of the Sacred Heart Cemetery grave stones.
  - Board Member Dopheide reported he has secured one flatbed trailer from Kevin Rupiper and will continue to pursue two more. Two concert tickets plus \$20.00 in food/drink tickets will be provided to owners for use of flatbed trailers.
  - Recommendation to park TCBA trailer on the west side of ball diamond to provide shade for the grillers in the hamburger stand.
  - Board Member Walsh requested Schwaller contact Vern Alatorre from G33K Productions regarding the location of his sound equipment from the stage.
  - Board Member Prebeck reported EMS will be located near south alley entrance.
  - Board Member Warner reported on Facebook page.
  - Board Member Schwaller reported Joe Behrens is working on concert poster/flyer.
  - Consensus of board was to allocate \$1,000 - \$1,200 for concert advertising.
  - Board discussed contacting Auen Distributing requesting a poster to hang promoting the July 20<sup>th</sup> concert during the Sacred Heart Church annual Street Dance on July 3, 2013.
  - Board Member Schwaller reported letter requesting volunteers to work the concert were mailed on June 17, 2013. There are 3 different shifts available to volunteer for: 6:30 p.m. – 9:00 p.m., 9:00 p.m. – 11:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. to closing. Volunteers will be given a special wrist band and admitted free into the music festival.
  - Discussed ordering 20 cases of water and 22 cases of pop.
