A motion was made by Prebeck and seconded by Sturm to approve minutes from February 6, 2013. All in favor, motion carried.

Old Business:

- Templeton Ball Field complex renovation update:
 - Board Member Warner reported on businesses interested in updating or purchasing a 4' x 8' outfield advertising sign. Warner will contact Cam Ross Sign Company, Audubon, Iowa.
 - Board Members discussed purchasing an outfield sign with the Templeton logo on. Consensus of board was to proceed.
 - Board Member Warner will look into ordering outfield footage field markers from Cam Ross Sign Company, Audubon, Iowa.
 - Board Member Warner reported Ryan & Jason Klocke dba Klocke Custom Cabinets offered to donate the materials and labor for the interior renovations to the concession stand.
 - Board Member Warner reported Rye Supply, Inc. and Gary & Mary Weitzl donated money towards the ball field renovation project.
 - Board Member Prebeck reported he contacted John at Midwest Wholesale requesting his assistance with the ball field fence and provide guidance on repairing it and adding an additional gate in left field.
 - Board Member Warner reported the Templeton Booster Club would be willing to contribute \$1,500 towards the renovation project.
 - A motion was made by Behrens to contribute \$2,000 towards the renovation project, seconded by Schwaller. All in favor, motion carried.

- July 20, 2013 Music Festival update:
 - Board Member Behrens reported he contacted but has not heard back from Templeton Rye Distillery regarding being a sponsor and authorization to use the “Rock & Rye” name to advertise the music festival event.
 - Board reviewed and made changes to the contracts with Crawford County Music and G33K Productions, Inc. Board authorized Schwaller and Behrens to finalize contracts.
 - Task assignment sheets handed out. No further action taken.

New Business:

- Board Member Walsh reported the fireworks tubes in the trailer need to be replaced. Board Member Walsh will compile estimated cost to replace tubes and report back to board.
- Board Member Walsh discussed the possibility of requesting funds from the TCBA if additional funds are needed to pay for the fireworks. Currently the fireworks is paid for through the collection of monetary deposits on cans and bottles the community donates.
