A motion was made by Dopheide and seconded by Walsh to approve the agenda. All in favor, motion carried.

A motion was made by Warner and seconded by Walsh to approve minutes from May 19, 2014. All in favor, motion carried.

Joe Behrens presented Secretary/Treasurer's Report:

- Checking - \$2,786.41
- CD #7947 - \$21,998.52 and CD #11039 - \$20,577.43
- Distributed checking account transaction report 5/20/14 through 9/15/14.
- Distributed certificate of deposit #7947 and #11039 transaction report.
- Carol Schoeppner found no discrepancies or misuse of TCBA funds after reviewing the months of May 2014, June 2014, & July 2014.

A motion was made by Dopheide and seconded by Warner to accept Secretary/Treasurer's Report. All in favor, motion carried.

Old Business:

- Discussed hosting dueling pianos.
 - Board Member Dopheide will continue to research & report back.
 - Possible dates discussed were December 31, 2014 and February 13 or 14, 2014.
 - Also discussed having bartenders volunteer, sell tickets for meal and dueling pianos, have the Templeton Still Restaurant cater.
- Other Old Business: None

New Business:

- Fireworks donation
 - \$500 donation to fireworks. A motion was made by Behrens and seconded by Sturm to approve \$500 donation. All in favor, motion carried.
 - Other \$500 donations will come from the City of Templeton & TADC & Sacred Heart Parish (Finance Board)
 - Recommend bigger shells for fireworks.

- Ball diamond electrical lines
 - Discussed having the panel on the Left Outfield pole & Left Centerfield pole lights.
 - Would have to split the costs of doing that 3 ways – TCBA, City of Templeton & Parish
 - All were consensus of approving the concept – will wait on final cost for further approval.
 - All agreed that an email approval on final cost would be sufficient.
 - Additional idea of adding a line from the 400 amp panel in banquet room to ball field pole – that way all electrical for ball field & Templeton Center would be on the same panel. Electricity cost sharing with the City of Templeton.
 - Everything would be underground – look better
 - Behrens will have Mark Bauer put an estimate together
- Additional ball diamond outfield advertising signs
 - Kerkhoff Craftsman would like to add an advertising sign to ball field
 - Warner will contact Cole Kerkhoff to get everything arranged.
 - Discussed the back of the signs facing the Templeton Center patio.
 - Possible ideas of having local artists / photographers design back side of signs.
- Other New Business
 - Bloodmobile Drive at Templeton Center – Monday, November 24, 2014
 - Cots will be in Gym, food in Cafeteria, need volunteers; Sacred Heart Guild will pay for food supplies.
 - All agreed that TCBA will pay for chili/soup – Sturm will inform TCBA of final pricing.
 - Fundraiser Ideas – Sturm found a website www.gigmasters.com for fundraising ideas.
 - Wine/Brewery Expo - \$20 entry fee, showcase local Iowa wineries, have speakers on the process of wine making or breweries. Also have Pampered Chef, Tastefully Simple, etc. supply appetizers & sell their items.
