SPECIAL MEETING

The Templeton Community Betterment Association met for a special meeting on the ninth day of December, 2015, at 7:30 p.m. at Templeton Community Center.

Board of Directors Present: Holly Warner, Emily Drees, Jill Spies, Amy Hanken, Jason Klein & Eric Kerkhoff.

Board of Directors Not Present: Ali Sturm

Others in Attendance: Rhonda Schwaller

A motion was made by Drees to approve the agenda, seconded by Warner. All in favor, motion carried.

A motion was made by Klein to approve the minutes from November 16, 2015 & seconded by Hanken. All in favor, motion carried.

Public Input: Rhonda Schwaller

Old Business:

A. Update on Rifle Raffle

1. \$5,600 in deposits from 140 tickets being sold
2. Rhonda would like to have a paper available to give to the gun raffle winner with their name and the name of the vendor & instruct the winner on how to obtain the gun.
3. Board Member Warner had drafted this information & the committee reviewed the paper & Rhonda will get Warner the specifics of each Vendor (Address, Phone Number, etc.) to update the document to give to the gun raffle winner.
4. Board Member Klein researched what the gun raffle winners need to have to obtain the gun. The winners will need to have a Permit to Purchase not a Permit to Carry. A Permit to Purchase can be acquired at the Sheriff's Office which is a one year permit for \$10.

B. Santa Coming to T-Town

1. Board Member Warner reported that Chris & Diane Dopheide got oranges, apples, fruit snacks & candy canes from HyVee for the treat bags. The Templeton Center has Christmas trees already decorated. Committee agreed no other decorations will be needed.

2. Judging is scheduled for Thursday, December 17, 2015 at 6:30pm meeting in front of City Hall.
3. Rhonda will remind Red to drive bus.
4. Rhonda also reported that only 2 individuals have signed up.
5. Committee agreed to have poster and forms available at Santa Coming to T-Town to remind residents.

D. 2015 New Year's Eve Party

1. Board Member Warner notified everyone that a couple residents had approached her asking if they could come after the meal for just the comedians and pay a discounted rate. Committee discussed the possible scenarios and everyone agreed to **not** offer any discounted tickets.

3. Board Member Warner will check with Kim Irlbeck and Lindsey Irlbeck about set up & clean-up and if bartenders can serve tables during the show.

5. Board Member Spies will look at Hobby Lobby/Nobbies in Des Moines for decorations (ex. hats, horns, clappers, etc.).
 6. Committee agreed to helping set up at the Templeton Center as will want to set up the tables in a “U” shape in front of the dance floor. Will determine time after talking with Kim Irlbeck.

New Business:
