Lenten Regulations on Fasting:

- A. Ash Wednesday is a day of fast and abstinence.
- B. Good Friday is also a day of fast and abstinence. People are encouraged to continue to fast, where possible, into Holy Saturday.
- C. The Fridays of Lent are to be observed as days of abstinence. For those 14 years of age or over, no meat is to be eaten on these days.
- D. Each individual Catholic should resolve to engage in other activities of prayer, fasting, almsgiving and mortification during the 40 days of Lent. The Celebration of Mass, Confession, generous assistance to the poor and religious/charitable causes should be a part of everyone's Lent.

Wednesday, February 22nd Ash Wednesday: Please see the Mass Schedule for times & places of Masses. A Collection for the Church in Central and Eastern Europe will be taken up. The Collection provides support for basic pastoral programs and makes scholarships available for students studying to serve their local church.

DON'T GIVE UP CHOCOLATE OR DESSERT THIS LENT! Instead join us on Wednesday mornings immediately after the 8:00 AM Mass at the parish house in Halbur. We will spend six weeks exploring the Sunday readings of Lent in a program called *Lenten Longings*. Members of all the parishes are welcome. We will begin on **Wednesday, February 29**. Use this as a time for some Lenten spiritual renewal.
