**BAPTISM** begins our journey of faith. The Church asks us to baptize as soon as possible after the birth of a child. Baptism is often celebrated outside of Mass. Baptism may also be celebrated during Mass. In fact, it is preferred to celebrate baptisms during Mass especially if both parents are Catholic as we have a larger community present to welcome the new child of God and due to the shortage of priests. Celebrating Baptism during Mass adds only a few minutes to the Mass. Preparation for sacraments is highly recommended, encouraged, and mandated by the Catholic Church before the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, First Reconciliation, First Communion, Marriage, and Holy Orders are celebrated. The Diocese of Sioux City mandates that "Every parish or group of parishes shall ensure sacramental preparation for parents prior to the baptism of each child. Godparents may also be encouraged to participate. Good pastoral discretion is to be used for appropriate catechesis for parents with a child born soon after the baptism of a sibling." The Diocese recommends that parents may be excused from baptism preparation if they have taken part in preparation for the baptism of a sibling within one to two years prior to the baptism of their new child. I recommend baptism class every five years for parents expecting another child. Parents expecting a child are expected to attend the Baptism Class offered quarterly in our parishes. Parents who have taken part in preparation for the baptism of a sibling within five years prior to the baptism of their new child are excused, but should notify the pastor of the pending birth and baptism. Godparents from other parishes are required to complete a "Godparent in Good Standing" form with their pastor. For baptisms of persons from other parishes, the permission of the proper pastor is required.

**BAPTISM CLASS** ... if you are expecting a child or wishing to baptize a child, please contact the parish office at Breda to register for baptism class [if this is your first child or if it has been more than five years since the baptism of your previous child]. The date of Baptism is to be arranged with the pastor after completion of a Baptism Class [held quarterly]. The next Baptism Class is Wednesday August 1, 7:00 p.m. at the Family Ministry Room at St. Bernard-Breda.

**MASS OFFERING REQUESTS** are to be given to Fr. Mark so he may record and schedule them in the parish intended. Please note, as of July 1 in the Diocese of Sioux City, the standard Mass Offering gift is \$10, up from \$5. Mass Offerings may be any amount, however the standard gift is now \$10. Remember this is not "THE Mass Intention." This is the presider's intention. There is only to be one intention per Mass with a few times when multiple intentions

may be offered. In addition, one [1] Mass each weekend the pastor is required to offer an intention 'For his Parishioners'.
