The Templeton City Council met on this twenty-second day of March 2021 at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall, Templeton, Iowa. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Behrens, and the roll was called showing the following named Council Members present and absent:

RESOLUTION NO. 1277-21

**RESOLUTION APPROVING CITY OF TEMPLETON'S ANNUAL BUDGET
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022**

WHEREAS, the Code of Iowa, Chapter 384, Section 16, requires that all cities prepare and adopt an annual budget of expenditures and receipts for at least the next fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk shall certify the necessary tax levy for the next fiscal year to the County Auditor; and

WHEREAS, the Notice of Public Hearing Budget Estimate was published on March 9, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Templeton City Council did hold a public hearing concerning the budget for FY2022 on March 22, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Templeton City Council, after hearing all taxpayers wishing to be heard and considering the statements made by them, gave final consideration to the proposed budget and any modifications proposed at the hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Templeton, Iowa that they do hereby approve the budget for FY2022 as attached in the budget forms.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the City Council of Templeton, Iowa that the Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the City Council of Templeton, Iowa that the City Clerk is directed to submit these forms to the Carroll County Auditor on or before March 31, 2021.
