**RESOLUTION NO. 1139-16**

**A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE REPAYMENT OF DEBT WITH  
TEMPLETON SAVINGS BANK FOR WATER METER REPLACEMENT PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Templeton has proposed to contract indebtedness in the principal amount of approximately \$50,000.00 with Templeton Savings Bank for the purpose of replacing existing water meters and for the purchase of necessary computer technology, software, receiver, charger and equipment; and

**WHEREAS**, the City seeks for the repayment of principal and interest in an expeditious manner and will use revenue generated from the General Fund, Water Fund, Debt Service Fund, or any other fund as allowed by the Iowa Code; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Templeton City Council authorizes the use of funds generated from the General Fund, Water Fund, Debt Service Fund, or any other fund as allowed by the Iowa Code for the repayment of debt (principal and interest) with Templeton Savings Bank subject to reimbursement of the funds owned from such account.
